INTRODUCTION

Our student seminars have been well received by students and teachers alike. Our full day seminar is broken into three elements:

- Key note presentation from speaker
- Personal processing time
- Small group discussion

OUTCOMES OF THE DAY

- What is it to be a man?
- Strategies for building a positive sense of manhood.
- Tools to entering manhood and leaving boyhood behind.
- Developing positive and healthy relationships.
- Relationships and sexual decision making from a Christian perspective (i.e. developing relationship skills and the importance of marriage)
- The science behind pornography.
- 4 key issues that many men are facing; identity, purpose, self-control, sex drive.
- The impact of media and marketing.
- The value and dignity of the human person.
- Models of manhood - becoming the man you really want to be.
- How to deal with the pressure of sexting

TYPICAL DAY

Here is an approximate outline of the day depending on school bell times. Please note: this can be restructured to fit your school period times.

Session 1 60-70 minutes <i>Groupwork</i> <i>*30mins</i>	RECESS	Session 2 40-50 minutes <i>Groupwork</i> <i>*30mins</i>	Session 3 20-30 minutes	LUNCH	Session 4 40-50 minutes <i>Groupwork</i> <i>*20mins</i>	Session 5 20-30 minutes Q&A 5-10 mins	FINISH
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*The 30 minute group work consists of 15 minutes working through a booklet with questions relating back to the presentation. The second 15 minutes is group discussions led by teachers (group discussion questions are provided within the booklet).

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IDEAL VENUE

- A lecture theatre with tiered seating is best
- A large classroom
- Room size should be a similar size to number of students participating
- We highly suggest students to be seated on chairs not on the floor
- Large open halls are not recommended
- Air-conditioned venue is ideal

Note: two similar venues are required

STAFFING

We have found that the day works best:

- If the teachers that are allocated can be there for the whole day
- The teacher to student ratio is no more than 1 teacher to 20 (this is to encourage open discussion within the group work)

COST

We do not charge per student. The seminar is charged at a flat day rate regardless of the number of students.
